

## Patient Safety Devices and Restraints

### **Restraint Vest**

Indication: Patients at risk of falls or those requiring a restraint to assist with medical treatment. Helps prevent unassisted bed or chair exit.

Sizes:

Small	item # 40147
Medium	item # 40154
Large	item # 40188
Xlarge	item # 40238

Item is to be placed in laundry. Laundry returns to CSPD.

Not patient chargeable.

**This is a restraint.**

### **Mitt Restraint**

Indication: Patients who disrupt medical treatment by pulling at their IV line/catheter or are prone to self-injury.

Adults: item # 46490. One size fits all

Pediatrics: item # 46490. Indicate size needed on comment line.

Item with Straps to be placed in laundry. Laundry returns to CSPD.

Not patient chargeable.

**This is a restraint** even if the mitt is just placed on the hand and not secured to anything.



### **Freedom Splint Restraint**

Indication: Patients requiring limitation of arm movement; to assist with IV therapy. Offers gentle reminder to restrict arm movement without resorting to rigid arm splints. Acts as an immobilizer for limbs to protect tubes or IV lines.

Sizes:

Small	item # 66381
Medium	item # 66399
Large	item # 66407

Single patient use. Dispose after use.

Not patient chargeable. Cost of item is \$12.22

**This is a restraint.**



### **Limb Holder Restraint**

Indication: Patients who disrupt medical treatment by pulling at their IV line/catheter or are prone to self-injury.

Adult: One size fits all item # 25460

Single patient use. Dispose after use.

Not patient chargeable. Cost is \$3.31

**This is a restraint.**



### **Overlay Happy Hands**

Indication: Patients with decreased cognitive function. Provides motor/sensory stimulation.

Item # 66415. Charged to patient-Cost is \$16.93. Item goes with patient. **This is a restraint if secured down.**



### **Wheelchair Wedge Gel Foam Cushion**

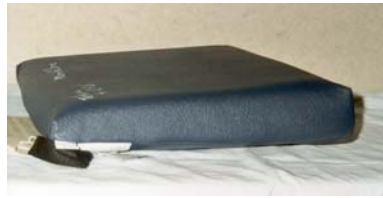
Indication: Patients at risk for sliding forward out of wheelchair, also those at risk for pressure sores and for those requiring posture support.

Order item under equipment: Gel Wedge.

Item to be returned to CSPD.

Not charged to patient

**Not a restraint.**



### **Tabs Device**

Indication: Patients who are at risk of falls from unassisted exits from bed or chair.

Order from CSPD through computer ordering system: Rental equipment M-Z as **TABS Device-Mobility Monitor** or **TABS Wheelchair Clip**

**Not a restraint.**



### **Bed-Check**

Bed-Check Sensormat and Chair-Check Sensormat

Indication: Patients who are at risk of falls from unassisted exits from bed or chair.

Bed-Check Monitor is ordered through computer ordering system: Rental equipment A-L as **Bed-Check Monitor System**.

Sensormats to be ordered from CSPD under supplies.

Mat Pressure Sensitive Chair-Check. Item # 540922. Cost is \$17.78-\$21.60

Mat Pressure Sensitive Bed-Check. Item # 540955. Cost is \$20.83-\$21.61

Not patient chargeable. Single patient use. Dispose after use.

**Not a restraint.**



NOTE: To obtain the TABS Device or Bed-Check after hours at MCSU, they are on a cart that is nearly straight ahead from the main entrance door to the CSPD area....past the desk with the computers and right next to the lift that is used to transport items upstairs to the OR rooms.

### **Seizure Pads for Beds**

Indication: Patients who are at risk of falls from unassisted exit from bed.

Item to be ordered under equipment.

Seizure Pad – Long -- Need 1 for each side of bed (uses Velcro)

Seizure Pad – Short – Need 2 for each side of bed (uses Velcro)

Seizure Pad – Hill Rom – Set of 4 (slips over rails)

Seizure Pad – TC Extenders only (for beds on 2E and 3E only)

Seizure Pad – Total Care Set (for beds on 2E and 3E only)

Not patient Chargeable. Items to be returned to CSPD.

**If used to keep patient in bed it is a restraint.**

**If used as protection from seizures, it is not a restraint.**

**Geri Chair**

Indication: Patients who are at risk of falls from unassisted exit from chair.

Item to be ordered under equipment from CSPD.

**Other Chair choices:**

**Lumex (reclines with tray)**

**Total Lift Chair (Pink Chair)**

**Invacare HTR Tilt/Recline**

If needing a specific chair-put name on the comment line when ordering.

Not patient chargeable. Item to be returned to CSPD.

**NOTE: The use of any chair is considered a restraint if used with the tray table**

**Posey Bed Canopy**

Indication: Patients who are at risks of falls from unassisted exit from bed. Allows freedom of movement while in bed.

MeritCare owns 3 units. To order contact CSPD. Staff must be trained in use before using.

**This is a restraint.**
