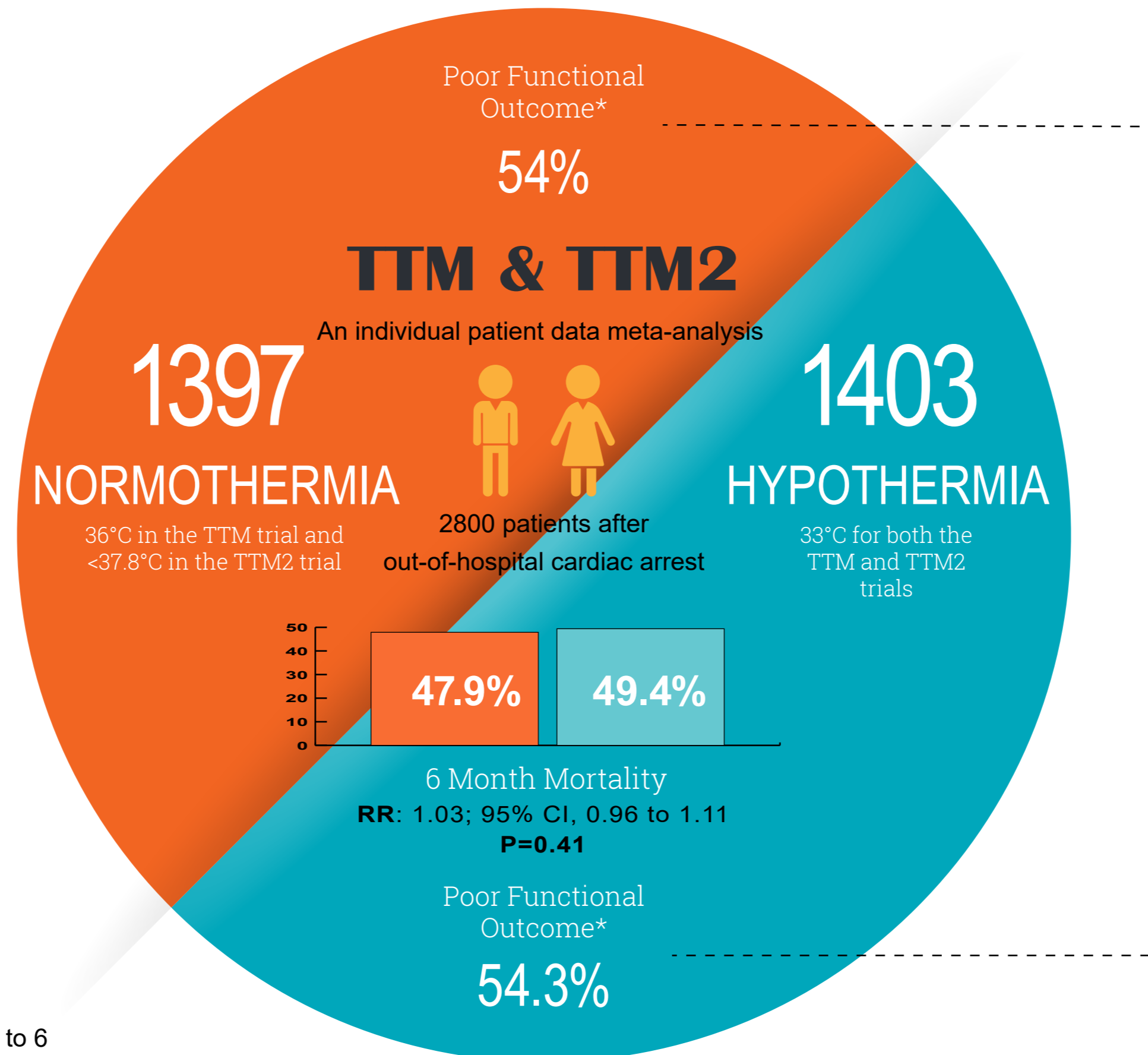


# Hypothermic versus Normothermic Temperature Control after Cardiac Arrest



**\*Poor functional outcome:**  
based on a modified Rankin scale score of 4 to 6



## CONCLUSION

Hypothermia at 33°C did not reduce 6-month mortality, nor did it improve favorable neurological outcome compared to normothermia 36-37.8°C.
