


Hypothermic versus Normothermic Temperature Control







Relative Risk with Hypothermia 1.01; 95% CI, 0.94 to 1.08 P=0.88

*Poor functional outcome:

based on a modified Rankin scale score of 4 to 6

CONCLUSION

Hypothermia at 33°C did not reduce 6-month mortality, nor did it improve favorable neurological outcome compared to normothermia 36-37.8°C.
