
Effect of Intravenous or Intraosseous Calcium vs Saline on Return of Spontaneous Circulation in Adults With Out-of-Hospital Cardiac Arrest

Double-blind, placebo-controlled randomized clinical trial



5 mmol of calcium chloride (735 mg of calcium chloride dihydrate, given IV bolus after the first epinephrine, repeated if still in cardiac arrest

Intravenous or intraosseous calcium did not improve the return of spontaneous circulation in patients with cardiac arrest.
