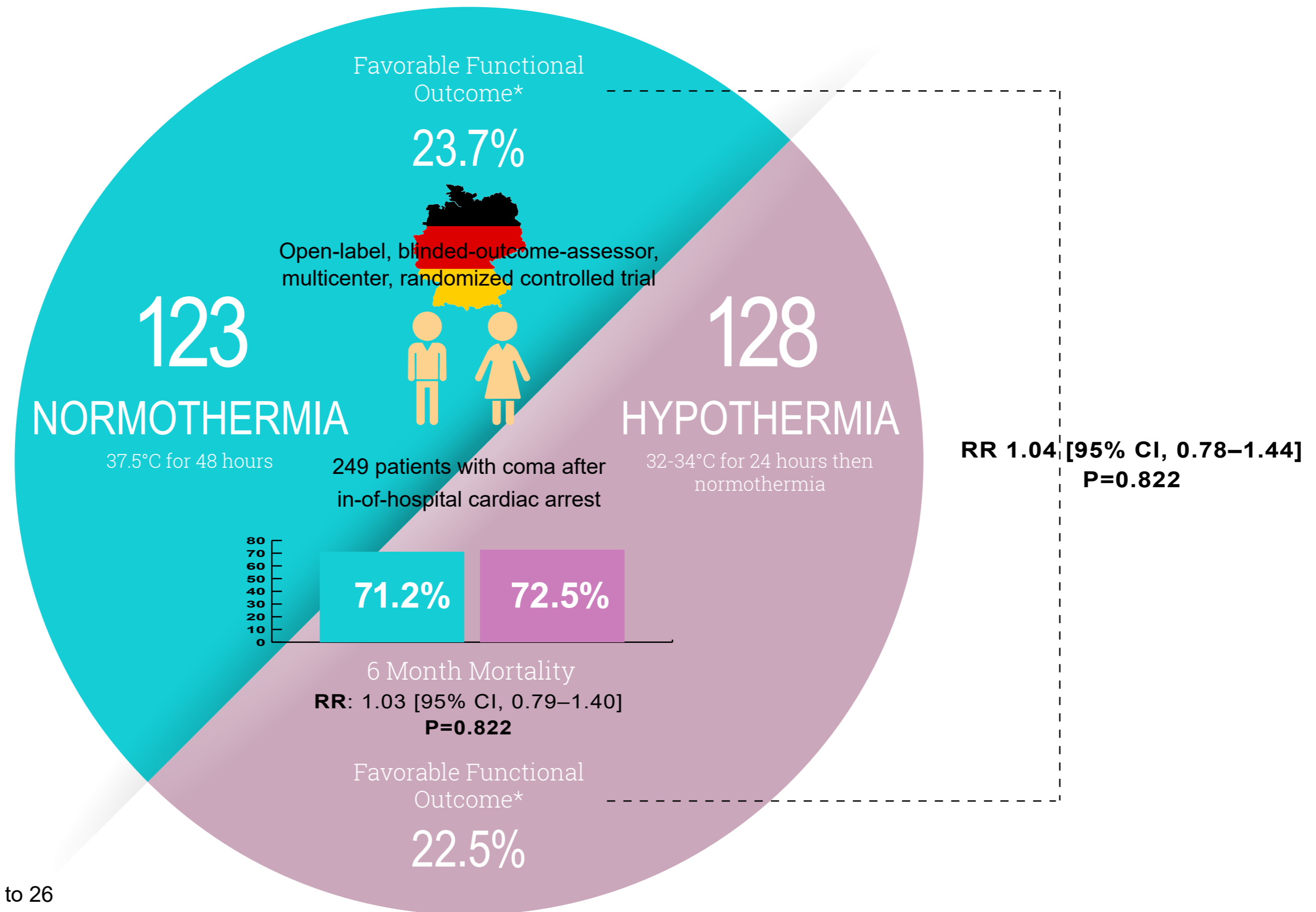


Temperature Control After In-Hospital Cardiac Arrest: A Randomized Clinical Trial

CONCLUSION

Hypothermia at 32-34°C did not reduce 180-day mortality, nor did it improve favorable neurological outcome compared to normothermia at 37.5°C in patients with coma after in-hospital cardiac arrest.
