
HIGH VERSUS LOW BLOOD-PRESSURE TARGET IN PATIENTS WITH SEPTIC SHOCK

In patient with septic shock, does a higher mean arterial pressure improve mortality compared to a lower mean arterial pressure?





Targeting a mean arterial pressure of 80-85 does not improve 28- or 90-day mortality in patients with septic shock compared to 65-70 mm Hg.
